**Bio:**

Morri has over 30 years' experience in government and not-for-profit agencies at a senior and practical level. He was involved in the development and introduction of standards of care in human services in NSW and also the restructure of non-government service provision as part of the government's business reform towards outsourcing human services functions.

For 11 years Morri was Chief Executive Officer of ACWA, the Association of Children's Welfare Agencies. In this capacity he represented 150 child and family welfare agencies with respect to policy, practice development, standards development and lobbying for government funding. His major achievements include establishing a national peak for children's services agencies and setting up the largest non-government training provider for the human services sector.

Morri is also experienced in dealing with government, having worked for the NSW Department of Community Services in out of home care. He was a member of the Usher Committee which restructured the out of home care system. He has also contracted with different levels of government in a range of capacities and has serviced many clients who are either government departments or government funded agencies.

In 1997 Morri established Matrix on Board, having identified a need to support not-for-profit organisations. The focus was on helping them to generate the information they need to make good decisions, particularly. Since that time he has worked with a wide range of organisations and has built up Matrix on Board into a significant and well-regarded service provider in the not-for-profit sector in Australia. The organisation currently employs 42 staff in 5 offices across 4 states. It works with a wide range of organisations, supporting their financial management functions and working with them to build their organisational capacity.
