Glenn has spent the majority of his working life in the human services sector, in particular in human resources and executive management. For the last 20 years, Glenn was Managing Director and CEO of Northcott Disability Services (formerly the NSW Society for Crippled Children). Under Glenn's leadership, Northcott experienced considerable growth and is now one of NSW's major providers of disability services.

Glenn was the inaugural Chair of Ability First Australia (the National Alliance of the former Crippled Children Societies around the nation) and is now its part time CEO, whilst also working with Nucleus as an expert advisor in the following areas:
