

Labour Force Participation


Results of the 2015 Survey of Disability Ageing and Carers (SDAC) have been released. The SDAC has reported the following figures in respect of labour force participation for people with disability aged 15 to 64 years.



The labour force participation rate for people with disability (53.4%) has remained steady since the 2012 SDAC (52.8%). This rate was higher for people without disability (83.2%).



Only 27% of people with disability were **EMPLOYED FULL-TIME** compared with 53.8% of those without disability.



In 2012, Australians with disability were **MORE LIKELY TO BE UNEMPLOYED** (10.0%) compared with those without disability (5.3%).



The labour force participation rate for people with severe or profound disability has **DROPPED 4.7%** since 2012.
