Proof of eligibility for COVID-19 vaccination

In 2021, the Australian Government will make the COVID-19 vaccine available to all Australians.

The vaccine is safe, effective and free.

As a person living with disability, you are part of [Priority Group 1](#) identified for vaccination against COVID-19. You are now eligible to receive a COVID-19 vaccine.

You do not have to book an appointment. Visit a vaccination centre and receive priority access

Please bring with you:

- Medicare card (if you have one)
- valid form of identification (for example, driver licence, proof of age card or passport)
- this letter as proof of eligibility and priority access.
